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Session I: Eye Care Camp at Western Railway Mazdoor Sangh (W.R.M.S.)

Today began with a visit to the Western Railway Headquarters, where the Mendonsa Foundation organized an **eye care camp** at the W.R.M.S for the employees of the railway headquarters. Key takeaways from the visit include:

1. Understanding the Registration Process:

We observed how the initial registration process plays a critical role in organizing the flow of patients and maintaining order during the camp.

2. Learning about Eye Diagnostic Equipment:

We were introduced to the **Refractometer**, which is used to measure the **refractive index** of the eye.

3. Optometrist Evaluation:

The next step involved an **Optometrist** using a **Phoropter** to determine the patient's eye "power" or vision prescription.

4. Ophthalmologist Referral & Examination:

If irregularities were found during the optometrist's checkup, the patient was referred to an **Ophthalmologist**, who used a **Slit Lamp Microscope** for a more detailed eye examination.

In addition to learning about the eye check-up process, we assisted in **crowd management** and supported various tasks to ensure smooth operation at the camp.

Session II: Don Bosco Empowerment Camp at St. Joseph's High School

In the second half of the day, we visited the **Don Bosco Empowerment Camp** hosted at **St. Joseph's High School**, which focuses on **skill development and education** for underprivileged communities. Key highlights:

1. Women Empowerment & Education Initiatives:

The camp provides **skill training** to women, enabling them to start their own businesses and contribute to household income. It also supports children by offering **tuition classes** and teaching **essential life skills** for future credibility.
